

EHTYO Board Meeting / Minutes from July 2, 2008

Coordinator's reports:

Debbie Young/ CMC Football: The Cape May County Football schedule is complete and there is only one game per weekend at the EHTYO field. Football camp will begin on July 15th from 6pm-8pm. The children must be an EHTYO participant because of our insurance. The AC Football coaches will be present and the AC boys are allowed to participate as long as there is no equipment being used. Tee shirts will be sold for \$5 each, we purchased 200 shirts, and they do not have a year on them. There will be a Football coaches meeting before July 15th.

Keith Transue/ AC Football: The AC Football schedule is final. The weight limit was increased by 5 pounds on each level. The birthdate cutoff is now July 1st, not September 1st, and the ACJFL will continue to use the Nike Footballs at games. Tony Savastano prepared an equipment wish list and it is approximately \$6,000. We will need another set of dates for football signups. There are 225 kids signed up so far: 47-varsity, 65-JV, 68-Pee Wee, and 45-Taxi. July 21st is the first day of equipment distribution. Bob Lincoln still has the helmets and footballs. Elmo would like the items highlighted on the football equipment list approved tonight by the Board so Tony can place the order tomorrow. We will hold football signups on July 14th, 15th, & 16th from 6pm-8pm at the fieldhouse. The store inside the announcer's booth has Booster Club items that are moldy and wet and it needs to be cleaned out ASAP. The golf cart needs a place to be stored. Elmo will call Ralph Clayton and see if he wants it.

Chuck Compton / Treasurer's Report: \$27,537.00 in account. This does not include June's football and cheerleading registration monies. Chuck distributed a list of returned checks to each coordinator for investigation. The following people requested a refund from Cheerleading: Mr. Fittipaldi (\$135), Ms. Williams (\$100), Mr. Adams (\$135), and Mr. Canale (\$135). Their children have decided to cheer on competitive cheerleading squads. Elmo also requested a \$30 refund to Ms. Kwart for a yearbook / add purchase last season.

Brenda Coholan / AC Cheerleading: received a call from Vicky from Brian Dunleavy's office stating that she released Slaybaugh to basketball on August 1st. We can have Davenport School on August 1st and Slaybaugh on August 2nd & 3rd for Cheerleading camp. Vicky also requested a copy of our insurance and our use of facilities request which has to be approved by the BOE. Elmo will call Vicky and see if we can remain at the same school for all 3 days of camp. The ACJCA meetings will now be held at our fieldhouse and the next meeting is Sunday, July 20th at 7pm.

Nina Mitchell / CMC Cheerleading: will hold another registration on Wednesday, July 16th from 6pm-7pm. She distributed copies of the ACJCA bylaws to all CMC cheerleading coaches so they can begin writing bylaws for CMC. She has been in contact with a coach from Ocean City and would like to hold a Cheerleading clinic for CMC cheerleaders in Ocean City on Saturday, August 23rd. If not, she would like to hold it at our field. Elmo told her to run it by Bob Lincoln but that it should not be a problem. 3 girls were approved to be placed on the JV squads due to low roster counts: Drew Valian and Jordan Valian for CMC and Ja'nece Coleman for AC. These girls all cheered last season and were unable to tryout this year.

Karen Wood / Drill Team: not present. Karen was approved for a new sound system for Drill Team and Bill Warrell found it for \$400 cheaper on ebay. It will be here in a few weeks since Bill had to reopen his account.

Lisa Angelastro / Booster Club: will not be here the weekend of the Kickoff party and she needs Board members to help out along with the parents, coaches, etc. Last year the food was donated by businesses and the parents brought drinks, desserts, etc. Friday, August 29th is the tentative date of this event. Lisa would like to start a list of committees with the parents as Nancy did last year. We would also like to hold a White & Orange game (scrimmage game) where we would divide up all of the kids, not AC vs. CMC.
