Coordinator's reports:

Cindy & Brenda / Cheerleading: practice is down to 2 nights a week. There are 5 new girls on Cape May Varsity. Tentative competition dates are November 5th & December 10th and possibly November 19th. Varsity Exhibition is November 8th, the coaches' dinner is November 19th at Touch of Italy, and Sand bowl is November 26th at Oak Crest. We are on the West with Absecon and EHC. There was a coaches' meeting last Thursday, Sept. 14th and medical release forms were given to all coaches. There was an incident at the JV game in Mayslanding involving a coach and a cheerleader. One of the Varsity Cape cheerleading coaches' mother is in intensive care.

Carol Johnson / Drill Team: Carol turned in \$465 for additional / late sign ups, along with the \$6,840.53 invoice for uniforms. We were reimbursed \$150 for the uniforms being shipped to the wrong school. Practice is on Thursday nights / rain place is Slaybaugh School. Scheduled to perform at the parade on Oct. 28th. Desperately need 2 new boom boxes. Drill will perform twice on Sept. 30th at the PAL games and home against Ventnor. Carol would like a 3rd person put on her checking account, Karen Wood.

Tony Savastano / ACFB: checking account still at \$137.15. There is a coaches' meeting on Thursday, Sept. 28th to reinforce the lock up rules & procedures. There are B Games the next 2 Monday nights.

Brenda Coholan / Treasurers' Report: \$23,726.48, with a few checks that have not cleared for a balance of \$18,800. Brenda purchased 31 rain ponchos for the cheerleaders and the board approved her to be reimbursed.

Presidents' Report / Tony Savastano: PAL hosts EHT Eagles on Sept. 30th and they will be having a picnic during the game. The new sound system is in place. The Twp. Committee met and decided to provide the ambulances for our home games and not be charged. There are 2 crews on duty during the day. On Oct. 3rd, the Mayor will have a forum and would like the following present: Varsity FB coaches, PAL coaches, and the High School coaches, due to the number of kids playing football in EHT. Secondly, he would like to meet with the Coordinators to discuss each branch of the organization. Tony will pick up the monies from the Charlie Canale fund this week.

Open Floor: The new skate park is looking for a sound system to be donated. It was voted & approved to donate our old one. Tony will research the information about the tax ID number soon. The accountant needs a brief bio on all board members. Tom Webb said that the sideline needs to be roped off for games. Tony bought an additional 200 feet of rope. Parents cannot pull out the posts from the field. The new goal posts will be installed once the cement settles.

The incident on Sept. 7th was discussed involving a JVAC Cheerleading coach and some boys watching the practice. The coaches statement is on record b/c she was unable to be present. The incident at the Mayslanding game was addressed with the parent of the cheerleader and the coach. Both incidents have been addressed with the coach by the Cheerleading Coordinators. No further action will be taken at this time.
