Lisa thanked Michele Fisher for her excellent book keeping and said she is very organized. Lisa also thanked Michele Franco for the beautiful decorations she did for Atlantic Homecoming. Thanked everyone who came out and helped Michele for Atlantic's homecoming. Lisa will need a key to the announcement stand by 8AM to get decorations out on Saturday. Tom Germana will be here and will make sure it is open for sales as well. Lisa asked Nina about the two new girls on Varsity and about the girl that quit. Nina stated there are no new girls on Varsity and no one had quit. The stand made a profit of \$3845.00 during Atlantic's Homecoming game.

There are two girls that showed an interest in joining the Varsity squad. One of the girls cheered last year and did not come back out for try-outs and the other moved here from Florida.
